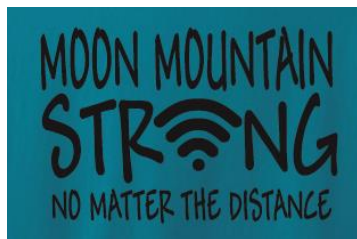
As a reminder, we ask parents do a health check of their students before sending them to school on their assigned day. Please keep your child at home if they are not feeling well.
